2020-2022 transmission facility owner tariff application

Proceeding 24798 EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc.'s application for approval of its 2020-2022 transmission facility owner (TFO) tariff to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the Commission to review before it makes its decision.

EPCOR has filed an application requesting approval of its 2020-2022 TFO tariff. The application is seeking approval of transmission revenue requirements of \$109.88 million in 2020, \$113.50 million in 2021, and \$116.27 million in 2022.

Written submissions are due August 15, 2019.

To register your concerns, or your support for the application, please visit the AUC website and log in to the eFiling System to file your submission for Proceeding 24798. If you do not have access to the internet, send your name, address, phone number, organization you are representing, description of your interest in the proceeding, position including information in support of the position and reasons why the AUC should decide in the manner recommended, and whether further process is required. If no written submissions are received, the Commission may make its decision without further notice or process.
