Application for 2018 annual transmission access charge deferral account true-up

Proceeding 24816 EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc.'s 2018 annual transmission access charge deferral account true-up to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc. has filed an application requesting approval for its 2018 annual transmission access charge deferral account true-up, an aggregate refund of approximately \$2.77 million, by way of a rider effective January 1, 2020, to December 31, 2020.

Written submissions are due August 30, 2019.
