## 2019-2020 general rate application compliance filing

### Proceeding 24817 ATCO Pipelines

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering ATCO Pipelines' 2019-2020 general rate application compliance filing to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

ATCO Pipelines, a division of ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd., filed an application with the Commission on August 15, 2019, requesting approval of its compliance filing to Decision 23793-D01-2019, ATCO Pipelines' 2019-2020 general rate application.<sup>1</sup> ATCO Pipelines also requested the Commission's approval and/or confirmation of:

- ATCO Pipelines' 2019 forecast revenue requirement of \$274,751,000 and its 2020 forecast revenue requirements of \$304,698,000 as final, subject to any placeholders;
- The finalization of all outstanding 2019 and 2020 reserve and deferral accounts;
- ATCO Pipelines' disposition of the information and technology costs and 2018 generic cost of capital placeholders; and
- ATCO Pipelines' compliance with directions given in the decision.

### **Written submissions are due August 27, 2019.**

To register your concerns, or your support for the application, please visit the AUC website and log in to the eFiling System to file your submission for Proceeding 24817. If you do not have access to the internet, send your name, address, phone number, organization you are representing, description of your interest in the proceeding, position including information in support of the position and reasons why the AUC should decide in the manner recommended, and whether further process is required. If no written submissions are received, the Commission may make its decision without further notice or process.
