Application for 2019 distribution tariff phase II filing

Proceeding 24820 ENMAX Power Corporation

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for ENMAX Power Corporation's 2019 distribution tariff phase II filing to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

In the application, ENMAX is requesting approval for:

- (a) changes to the rates charged to customers for the distribution of electricity, including rate rebalancing and rate design changes, effective January 1, 2021;
- (b) changes to the rates charged to customers for the transmission of electricity, including rate rebalancing, an increase to the system access service levels, and an update to the forecast pool price, effective January 1, 2021;
- (c) Distribution Tariff Customer Terms and Conditions and Distribution Tariff Retailer Terms and Conditions, effective one month following the release of the Commission's decision in this proceeding;
- (d) updated Loss Factors in its 2017 distribution line loss study; and
- (e) 2019 streetlight fixture forecast billing determinant.

ENMAX engaged Chymko Consulting Ltd. to provide a Cost Allocation Study to allocate ENMAX's distribution-related costs to its rate classes. ENMAX also engaged Elenchus Research Associates, Inc. to review its current distribution rate design and to recommend changes to align with the results of the Cost Allocation Study.

The table below illustrates the rate class impact that would arise by implementing the proposed distribution and transmission tariff rate changes.

Rate class	Total bill impact (%)*
	Typical usage
D100 (Residential)	1.1
D200 (Small Commercial)	0.3
D300 (Medium Commercial)	-3.0
D310 (Large Commercial Rate - Secondary)	-1.3
D410 (Large Commercial - Primary)	-3.3
D500 (Streetlights)	7.2
