## Application for sale of Wildhorse International Power Line to Express Pipeline Ltd.

### Proceeding 24826 TransCanada Energy Ltd.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for TransCanada Energy Ltd. (TCE) involving the sale of Wildhorse International Power Line (the Wildhorse Line) to Express Pipeline Ltd. (Express) to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

TCE filed an application with the Commission on August 22, 2019, informing the Commission that on July 4, 2019, TCE and Express entered into an asset purchase and sale agreement wherein TCE agreed to sell to Express its 69 kilovolt electric power transmission line, the Wildhorse Line. The Wildhorse Line only provides electric power to an oil pipeline station known as the Wildhorse Pump Station, owned and operated by Express, and is not physically interconnected with the Alberta Interconnected Electric System.

TCE and Express requested that TCE be released from the Commission's direction in Decision 23394-D01-2018,<sup>1</sup> which was to advise the Commission if Express ceases to receive electricity services from the Wildhorse Line. In the application, TCE and Express advised that Express continues to receive electricity services from the Wildhorse Line.

### Written submissions are due September 4, 2019.

To register your concerns, or your support for the application, please visit the AUC website and log in to the eFiling System to file your submission for Proceeding 24826. If you do not have access to the internet, send your name, address, phone number, organization you are representing, description of your interest in the proceeding, position including information in support of the position and reasons why the AUC should decide in the manner recommended, and whether further process is required. If no written submissions are received, the Commission may make its decision without further notice or process.
