ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 30475 to decrease the maximum operating pressure of line 1 under Licence 30475 from 8,480 kilopascals to 5,520 kilopascals.

The Commission amended Licence 30475 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act*, in Decision 24781-D01-2019¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
