AltaGas Utilities Inc. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 6192 for the following:

- addition of a newly constructed pipeline (line 50 – 0.04 kilometres of 219.1-millimetre outside-diameter pipeline)
- addition of a newly constructed pipeline (line 51 – 12.79 kilometres of 219.1-millimetre outside-diameter pipeline)
- addition of a newly constructed pipeline (line 52 – 0.01 kilometres of 114.3-millimetre outside-diameter pipeline)
- addition of a newly constructed pipeline (line 53 – 0.10 kilometres of 168.3-millimetre outside-diameter pipeline)

The Commission amended Licence 6192 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 24586-D01-2019¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
