ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 835 for the following:

- splitting line 12 into lines 12 and 13
- removal of line 12
- “From Location” legal subdivision amendments of lines 10 and 12
- “To Location” legal subdivision amendment of line 2
- pipe grade amendments of lines 2, 11 and 12
- mapping amendments of lines 2, 10, 11 and 12

The Commission amended Licence 835 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 24782-D01-2019¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
