The Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) released Administration Fee Order No. AF2008-10 on June 27, 2008. Administration Fee Order No. AF2008-10 contained the following text:

“The Commission, pursuant to section 70 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* and Rule 025, Administration Fee, orders the above mentioned utility to pay an administration fee of \$ 713,717.00 as follows:

- (a) 60% on August 1, 2008 which is \$ 428,230.20
- (b) 40% on October 31, 2008 which is \$ 285,486.80”

The Commission discovered two of the inputs that it used in determining the allocation of administration fee for Category 5 utilities were incorrect. Consequently, the Commission revised the Administration Fee Orders for the Category 5 utilities using the correct inputs. The corrected order for ENMAX Energy Corporation, with the changes highlighted in bold, is as follows:

The Commission, pursuant to section 70 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* and Rule 025, Administration Fee, orders the above mentioned utility to pay an administration fee of **\$735,035.00** as follows:

- (a) 60% on August 1, 2008 which is **\$441,021.00**
- (b) 40% on October 31, 2008 which is **\$294,014.00**
