The Alberta Utilities Commission (Commission) released Administration Fee Order No. 2008-13 on June 27, 2008. Administration Fee Order 2008-13 contained the following text:

“The Commission, pursuant to section 70 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* and Rule 025, Administration Fee, orders the above mentioned utility to pay an administration fee of \$327,894.00 as follows:

- (a) 60% on August 1, 2008 which is \$196,736.40
- (b) 40% on October 31, 2008 which is \$131,157.60”

The Commission discovered two of the inputs that it used in determining the allocation of administration fee for Category 5 utilities were incorrect. Consequently, the Commission revised the Administration Fee Orders for the Category 5 utilities using the correct inputs. The corrected order for Direct Energy Marketing Limited, with the changes highlighted in bold, is as follows:

The Commission, pursuant to section 70 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* and Rule 025, Administration Fee, orders the above mentioned utility to pay an administration fee of **\$342,824.00** as follows:

- (a) 60% on August 1, 2008 which is **\$205,694.40**
- (b) 40% on October 31, 2008 which is **\$137,129.60**
