## Proposed Changes of Rule 021, Settlement System Code

As a result of the implementation of the Micro-Generation Regulation (Alta. Regulation 27/2008) and the associated AUC Rule 024 (Rules respecting Micro-Generation), the AUC staff has examined the consequential changes that are needed to Rule 021 (Settlement System Code) and also prepared a draft version of Rule 021 with the proposed changes. AUC staff is now seeking comments on the proposed changes from interested stakeholders.

To assist stakeholders, a comment matrix has been prepared by AUC staff for interested parties to use. In providing comments, stakeholders are requested to state clearly, where applicable, the principles upon which your comments are based. The expectation will be that a revised version of the Rule 021 will be finalized in August with an effective date of January 1, 2009.
