

\$313,179 is recovered. The Review Panel notes that the collection of the total deficiency began on July 1, 2006.

The table below shows the approved rates to be paid by LWW customers:

## 5 ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- (1) Langdon Waterworks Limited revise Rate Schedule 1 to reflect the Board approved Metered Consumption Charge: \$1.617 per cubic meter effective May 1, 2007 to be reduced by \$0.280 to \$1.338 in the month following the month in which the Hearing Cost Reserve Account balance reaches \$100,000.
- (2) Langdon Waterworks Limited revise Rate Schedule 1 to reflect the Board approved 2004/2005 Deficiency Rider: \$0.647 per cubic effective from July 1, 2006 until the total deficiency of \$313,179 is recovered.

<sup>47</sup> As per Decision 2006-068 and this decision, once the hearing costs reserve account balance reaches \$100,000 the consumption charge is to be reduced by \$0.028 per cubic meter.

<sup>48</sup> As per Decision 2006-068 this rider would have expired July 1, 2007, however this decision now leaves that rider in effect until the revised deficiency is collected.
