Proposed amendments to AUC Rule 002 will reduce regulatory burden and improve efficiency

The government of Alberta introduced the *Red Tape Reduction Act* to reduce regulatory burden and improve regulatory efficiency. Agencies, including the Alberta Utilities Commission, form part of this commitment and the Commission is reviewing its rules in order to reduce the regulatory requirements contained within the rules.

The Commission is proposing amendments to Rule 002: *Service Quality and Reliability Performance Monitoring and Reporting for Owners of Electric Distribution Systems and for Gas Distributors* that will:

- Replace quarterly reporting requirements with semi-annual reporting requirements.
- Reduce other reporting requirements.

The Commission's review of Rule 002 will consist of a stakeholder consultation involving a written process.
