## **Market Surveillance Administrator proposes amendments to AUC Rule 019**

The Alberta Utilities Commission is seeking stakeholder feedback on revisions to AUC [Rule 019: Specified Penalties for Contraventions of ISO Rules](#) proposed by the Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA).

The Commission is proposing to accept the following MSA-recommended amendments to Rule 019:

- Rule 019 to apply to all independent system operator (ISO) rules.
- The current three categories of contraventions be collapsed into one category.
- The penalty escalation currently found in the Category 1 table be the one used to determine the penalty amount for subsequent contraventions of the same ISO rule.

The Commission's review of Rule 019 will consist of a stakeholder consultation involving a written process.

The AUC Engage forum, found through the AUC website, will be used to gather input and feedback related to this consultation.
