New maps available for in-service, approved and applied-for wind and solar projects

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC) now has maps available on its website that indicate the locations of wind and solar projects in Alberta. The two separate maps, one for [central Alberta](#) and another for [southern Alberta](#), show the location of wind and solar projects that have been:

- approved, constructed and operating (in-service).
- approved and not constructed.
- applied for, but are still under review.

The maps will be updated monthly and can be found through the above links or through the [Renewable Power Generation page](#) found from the home page on the AUC website.

This new resource is intended to assist municipalities, landowners and applicants because the maps will identify the locations and proposed locations of all wind and solar generation projects in the province.
