AltaGas Utilities Inc. Emergency Management Guide Review – Management Responses

In response to the Alberta Utilities Commission's ("AUC" or "Commission") review of the AltaGas Utilities Inc. (AUI) Emergency Management programs, AUI submits its management response and supporting documents to the recommendations forthcoming from the reports.

For clarity, AUI is a natural gas distribution utility in the province of Alberta operating approximately 22,000 km's of natural gas pipelines in and around 90 communities, serving almost 75,000 residential, rural and commercial customers in the province. The focus of AUI's business is the distribution of sweet natural gas to the end-use customer; AUI is not a transmission or gas gathering company. AUI does not operate wells or leases, nor does it own or transport H₂S, high vapour pressure or liquids in its pipelines.

Of the total pipe installed, approximately 1,500 km's are high-pressure distribution lines (operate at pressures over 700 kPa) and are relevant to this review. These small diameter pipelines are relatively short segments of pipe moving natural gas from transmission pipelines owned by others to AUI regulator station facilities.

Further to AUI's request of June 2, 2014 for clarification regarding the confidentiality of documents submitted to the Commission, we thank the Commission for confirmation all supporting documents submitted will remain confidential.
