

## Release summary

An updated version of the eFiling System is being released on April 8, 2017. The focus of this particular release (version 1.02.01) is on minor enhancements including a significant change to display the exhibit number in the file title when downloading documents for off-line use.

These release notes provide the details of the release and are broken down into three areas: new features, known issues and fixes. The details are grouped by functional areas.

## New features

A new feature is a functional change that has been requested and approved to be incorporated into the system.

### Documents

When documents are downloaded through the zip and download functionality, the exhibit number has been added to precede the file name. This change will facilitate the quick display of exhibits during a hearing when multiple documents are open and when the windows are minimized. The convention is now as follows:

Proceeding ID\_Exhibit number\_File name\_Document ID.file format

**Example with an exhibit number:** 22361\_X0010\_Acknowledgementletter\_0017.docx

**Example without an exhibit number:** 22361\_[ ]\_NoticeofApplication\_0125.pdf

The zip and download functionality has been upgraded to increase speed and reliability of downloading proceeding documents. The improved efficiency of the downloader will allow registered parties to download full proceeding records with ease along with a full index to reference the files by various attributes similar to the screens within the eFiling System.

Language has been added to the **Upload revision documents** screen for users revising an Excel document to please list the cell number for each revised cell and underline the revisions made. Revised cells do not include cells where the formulas are unchanged but the values are updated because of changes to other cells referenced in the formulas.

### Find

The ability to **Find schedules** by the proceeding ID has been added to both the internal and external site.

## Known issues

A known issue is a problem with the system that has been reported and requires additional investigation.

There are no outstanding issues reported for the eFiling System on the AUC website.

## Fixes

A fix is a correction to the system where it was producing an error or was not operating as originally designed.

### Accounts

When an organizational user changes their password, the user is now redirected back to the **Change general information** tab after they confirm their password change instead of being left at the **Change password** screen.

### Applications

The issue of editing a power plant form after a location is added or removed has been resolved.

You can now see more than 29 applications on the **Applications** page on the external site.

### Dispositions

When selecting a link to a rescinded disposition from the **Disposition details** page, the proceeding context did not change to the proceeding of the rescinded disposition. This has now been corrected.

### Find

Spaces may now be entered on the proceeding number or description text box on **Find Proceedings** without generating an error.

The error has been corrected when entering text in the proceeding field on **Find Dispositions** on the external
