**Application closure**

1. On April 19, 2017, NextEra Canada Development & Acquisitions, Inc. filed an application with the Alberta Utilities Commission for a time extension to complete construction of the 291-megawatt Heritage Wind Farm power plant. On March 30, 2018, NextEra applied to amend the Heritage Wind Farm including changing the type of wind turbines, number of turbines, and overall capability of the power plant.
2. On October 1, 2019, NextEra wrote to the Commission and advised that several factors had changed since the submission of its amendment and that it was no longer prudent to pursue it. NextEra indicated that it would consider submitting a new application in the future.<sup>1</sup>
3. Pursuant to Subsection 12.2 of Rule 001: *Rules of Practice*, the Commission may allow an applicant to withdraw an application on any terms it considers necessary. The Commission accepts the request to withdraw the application and will proceed to close Application 22579-A001 and Proceeding 22579 without further process.
