## Application for transmission line structure replacements on Home Road N.W. in Calgary has been received

### Proceeding 23981 Application 23981-A001

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the electric transmission line alteration application in Proceeding 23981. If you feel you may be affected by this application you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

### Written submissions are due February 1, 2019.

ENMAX Power Corporation has applied, under the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, to remove and replace seven steel-lattice transmission line structures along a one-kilometre segment of double-circuit transmission line 69-15.62L/21.61L. The structures would be replaced with self-supporting steel monopoles within the existing transmission line alignment. The new structures would be approximately five to 14 metres taller and range in height from 25 to 35 metres.

The transmission line structures are located on Home Road N.W. in Calgary between the ENMAX No. 15 Substation and 32 Avenue N.W. as shown on the attached map.

### Additional information about the application

The replacement monopole structures would be located within approximately five metres of the existing steel-lattice structures with the exception of pole 69-15.62-19, which would be 45 metres north of the existing location near 17 Avenue N.W.
