

# Notice of revised virtual hearing ENMAX No. 1 Substation Replacement Project

## ENMAX Power Corporation has filed applications to replace the No. 1 Substation in downtown Calgary

**Proceeding 25206  
Applications 25206-A001 to 25206-A008**

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be holding a virtual oral hearing to review the applications and submissions received to consider the electric transmission development applications in Proceeding 25206.

**Applicant reply evidence is due September 15, 2020.**

ENMAX Power Corporation has applied for permits and licences to construct and operate a new No. 1 Substation, to alter transmission lines 138-1.80L, 138-1.81L, 138-1.82L, 138-1.83L, 138.84L and 138-1.85L, and to decommission the existing EN 1S Substation. The existing transmission lines connected to the existing substation would be altered to connect to the new substation. The proposed new No. 1 Substation would be located on the north side of Ninth Avenue Southwest between Seventh and Eighth Street Southwest, in downtown Calgary. The applications have been filed under the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*.

**The Commission will hold a virtual oral hearing commencing on October 14, 2020, at 10 a.m. This oral hearing will be held remotely using a videoconferencing platform. Participants are responsible for ensuring that they have access to all documentary evidence filed on the record of the proceeding, either through the eFiling System or in their preferred format.**

**Oral argument will commence virtually on October 20, 2020, at 10 a.m., followed by reply argument.**

**The Commission will also hold two test sessions on October 13, 2020, at 1 p.m. and October 19, 2020, at 1 p.m., so that any technological issues can be identified and resolved in advance of the hearing. All hearing participants are required to participate in the test sessions.**

**Commission staff will contact the hearing participants and will send email invitations that include the link to access the test session, hearing, and argument and reply.**

A recording of the hearing will be available on the Commission’s website, if possible. A court reporter will provide transcription services, and transcripts will be available for purchase from Amicus Reporting Group, A Veritext Company.
